- [Tiki Wiki CMS Groupware](#) for most data management as it is [the Free / Libre / Open Source Web Application with the most built-in features](#)
  - It includes code from multiple other projects, including [Cypht](#) webmail.
- [Manticore Search](#)
- [Openfire](#) including [Jitsi Meet](#), [Pàdé](#) and [Converse](#) Real-time unified collaboration (Videoconference and so much more)
- [Syncthing](#) File sync & backup
- Options, depending on your use case
  - [MeshCentral](#) for remote computer management
  - [FusionPBX](#) & [FreeSWITCH](#) SIP telephony
  - [Xibo](#) Digital Signage
