

Prosody

Prosody is a lightweight and flexible **XMPP server** written in Lua. It provides the backbone for **real-time communication** — including instant messaging, presence, and group chat — using the open **XMPP (Extensible Messaging and Presence Protocol)** standard.

Designed for both **simplicity and performance**, Prosody is easy to configure, secure, and highly extensible through a wide range of community modules.

Within **WikiSuite**, Prosody can provide **chat, presence**, and **real-time collaboration** services for users. With [appropriate configuration](#) (for example using Tiki's Prosody integration module or userlist bridge), it can be linked to **Tiki** for unified user management and authentication.
