# WikiSuite vs Google

Google started out with indexing and organizing publicly accessible data, and later added all kinds of tools to manage organizational and personal data. [The main source of revenue is advertising.](#)

WikiSuite can be seen as a FLOSS

self-hosted alternative to G Suite (aka Google Apps). So for most of the tools that Google offers to manage your **organizational data** (including personal data in the case of home/family use), WikiSuite has an alternative. However, WikiSuite is not in the game of indexing public data, although something like [DuckDuckGo](#) or [YaCy](#) could be added later on.

## Similarities

- Both are full-featured platforms, with a high level of integration to manage organizational data

## Differences

- Google is proprietary SaaS while WikiSuite is Free / Libre / Open Source software.

<a href="#">Apps Script</a> or <a href="#">Google App Maker</a>	For <a href="#">End user programming</a> , use the existing feature set in Tiki, especially <a href="#">Trackers</a> . <a href="#">JavaScript</a> , <a href="#">jQuery</a> and many other <a href="#">Wiki Plugins</a> can be used. For more advanced use cases, you can use Tiki as <a href="#">Framework</a> or even direct PHP and JavaScript.

## Public data

Google	WikiSuite
<a href="#">Search</a>	We won't do search of public data, but for all your internal data: we have a search engine, including <a href="#">Search within files</a> and increasingly some <a href="#">Natural Language Processing (NLP)</a> features.
<a href="#">News</a>	Tiki can aggregate news via RSS: <a href="#">Article Generator</a> Similar to <a href="#">Alerts</a> , Tiki offers <a href="#">Stored Search</a> .
<a href="#">Maps</a>	Tiki <a href="#">Maps</a> can use Google Maps but also <a href="#">OpenStreetMap</a> and others thanks to <a href="#">OpenLayers</a> .
<a href="#">Google Shopping</a> is a price comparison tool, which WikiSuite doesn't offer.	But Tiki does offer a <a href="#">Shopping Cart</a> .
Similarly, WikiSuite doesn't offer functionality like <a href="#">Google Wallet</a>	but Tiki does offer a <a href="#">Payment</a> feature, and a system to track <a href="#">Credits</a> .
