- [Tiki](#) converted to Bootstrap 3 in Tiki 13, along with [Bootswatch](#), and Bootstrap 4 in Tiki 19.
- [Virtualmin](#): [Webmin/Usermin/Virtualmin/Cloudmin](#) theme based on [Bootstrap](#) and [Font Awesome](#)
- [Syncting](#) uses Bootstrap since day 1, and [Bootswatch](#) was added recently.
- [Kimchi](#): done v3 now working on v4
- [Kibana](#) uses Bootstrap
- [FusionPBX](#) done
- [Converse](#)-> Done in 4.0.
- [Openfire](#) admin panel: Done in version 4.5 as part of an admin panel modernization
